- The School District has partnered with the Health Care District of PBC to offer Pfizer vaccines at 4 locations for students 12 and up (w/parental consent), and staff and their families via the HCD Mobile Clinic on select days through Aug 8. No appointment or insurance necessary.
- The first draft of proposed themes, goals, and measures under consideration for inclusion in the next Strategic Plan was shared on June 2. ### GROWTH MANAGEMENT – DAGMAR BRAHS

- The Hypoluxo Village Project on the NE corner of Hypoluxo Rd. and Military Trail is requesting a change in the zoning designation to Multiple Use Planned Development (MUPD).
  - The proposed 31.98-acre site will be 129,210 total square feet including retail, restaurants, a self-storage building, gas station, residential apartments and preserve/recreation areas.
  - The preserve/conservation area is for public use.
  - The residential apartments will total 384 units with 88 being workforce housing. 96 units will use TDRs and the density will be 12 du/ac.
- The Delegates' Vote, was emailed to delegates prior to the meeting and will close at day's end. At the time of the meeting 45-3 were in favor of recommending it to the County with the condition that all elements be architecturally consistent with the transitional Mediterranean style.

### PRESIDENT'S REMARKS – BETH RAPPAPORT

- Reported that the Audit Committee, having performed its duties, is satisfied that the books and records of the organization fairly represent the financial position for the year ending April 30, 2021.
- Outdoor concerts resume at Canyon Town Center with a 3-part miniseries "Feelin' Nostalgic" beginning on Oct. 16.
